



Voting via Election Buddy

The electronic vote for the Unifor Local 1990 Executive Committee Election 2025 will be conducted using Election Buddy. This is an online platform for voting.

All voting members will be sent a **unique** email when voting opens. (CCSD employees will receive this email in their @cssd.ab.ca email account.)

This email contains a direct **unique** link to vote. It also gives the option to go to <https://secure.electionbuddy.com/ballot/> and enter a unique identifier provided in the email.

Do not forward or share your Election Buddy email or unique identifier with anyone else.

If you do not receive your Election Buddy email by 9am on Tuesday, May 20th, please follow the steps below to ensure it is not in your junk or another folder. If you are unable to find your election Buddy E-mail, contact the Election Committee to request assistance.

Results will not be available until the election is closed. In accordance with Unifor Policy, elections must be won by majority. If a majority is not achieved by a candidate, a runoff election will be called and further information will be provided to voters.

Because this email is being sent to your District email, but originated from outside of the district, it may be marked as “junk” or may be relegated to the “other” section of your inbox. To check these area:

Option A - Cellphone:

1. On your cellphone, open your district email in your web browser.
 - a. Search in your “other” folder
 - i. Toward the top of the page, you should see the “focused” and “other” options.
 - ii. Tap on “other” to view the contents of the “other” mailbox section.
 - b. Search on your “junk” folder
 - i. Tap on the three horizontal lines at the top left of the window
 - ii. Scroll down until you find “junk email”. It will be toward the bottom
 - iii. Tap on “junk email” to view the contents of the junkmail folder
 - c. Search in “all folders”
 - i. At the top right of the window, tap on the magnifying glass.
 - ii. Search for “unifor local 1990 election committee”
 - iii. If your search comes up with no email results, ensure the “results in” option is set to all folders. *NOTE: The default setting is typically to only search the folder you are currently in.*
2. If you were unsuccessful, please try Option B or C, or contact the Election Committee for assistance.

Option B - Web Browser:

1. On a computer, open your district email in your web browser.
 - a. Search in your “other” folder
 - i. Toward the top of the inbox, you should see the “focused” and “other” options.
 - ii. click on “other” to view the contents of the “other” mailbox section.
 - b. Search on your “junk” folder
 - i. If you do not see the navigation pane at the left side of the window, tap on the three horizontal lines at the top left of the window to show the navigation pane.
 - ii. In the navigation pane, scroll down until you find “junk email”. It will be toward the bottom
 - iii. Click on “junk email” to view the contents of the junk mail folder
 - c. Search in “all folders”
 - i. At the top of the window, click on the search bar.
 - ii. Search for “unifor local 1990 election committee”
 - iii. Ensure the drop down option to the left of the search bar has “all folders” selected as the search option.
2. If you were unsuccessful, please try Option A or C, or contact the Election Committee for assistance.

Option C - Outlook Desktop App:

1. On a computer, open your district email in your outlook desktop app.
 - d. Search in your “other” folder
 - i. Toward the top of the inbox, you should see the “focused” and “other” options.
 - ii. click on “other” to view the contents of the “other” mailbox section.
 - e. Search on your “junk” folder
 - i. If you do not see the navigation pane at the left side of the window, click on the small < symbol to show the navigation pane.
